**REPORT OF A SAFETY RECALL OR OTHER SAFETY CAMPAIGN
IN A FOREIGN COUNTRY**

1. Manufacturer

Nissan Motor (Thailand) Company, Ltd., Thailand.

2. Vehicles Potentially Involved

Nissan Navara vehicles produced from August 31, 2009 to October 30, 2009 at the Nissan Motor (Thailand) Co., Ltd., in Thailand equipped with 205/R16 tires manufactured by Continental. No vehicles sold in the United States are affected. Substantially similar vehicles sold in the U.S. are manufactured at different factories in North America and Japan, and are equipped with completely different tires.

3. Total Number of Vehicles Potentially Involved

Total: Approximately 1,021.

4. Description of the Defect

Due to an improper operation during the molding process of the green tire tread splice, the co-vulcanization at the tread splice was insufficient on certain tires. This could cause the tread splice to open or the tread rubber to partially separate.

5. Foreign Country in which the Safety Recall or Other Safety Campaign is Being Conducted

Algeria, Angola, Chile, Cambodia, Colombia, Ecuador, Ghana, Laos, Peru, Philippines and Panama.

6. Date of Determination

August 26, 2010.

7. Determination Made By

Manufacturer

8. Date the Recall or Other Campaign will Commence

Mid-September, 2010.

9. Descriptive of Corrective Action

Owners of potentially affected vehicles will be notified to take their vehicle to a tire service dealer of the tire supplier. The serial number on the tire will be inspected to determine the tire's production date. If the tire was produced in the affected period, it will be replaced with a new tire.

10. Vehicles in the United States (If known)

The following vehicles sold in the U.S. are on a similar "platform" as the Nissan Navara vehicles sold in the above countries:
Model year 2005-2010 Nissan Frontier, Pathfinder, Xterra;
Model year 2009-2010 Suzuki Equator and;
Model year 2004-2010 Nissan Titan, Armada, Infiniti QX56;
Model year 2011 Infiniti QX56.

This issue does not affect the above vehicles sold in the U.S. because these vehicles are manufactured at different factories in North America and Japan, and are equipped with completely different tires that are not affected by the recall condition.
