DESCRIPTION OF DEFECT:

Volvo has voluntarily decided to perform a non-compliance recall on the affected vehicles to check the fuel line connectors and if necessary replace the fuel lines. The connectors for fuel line and purge line may have been mixed up. This may result in fuel seepage under some driving conditions which affects emissions compliance.
