The following information is submitted in accordance with the reporting regulations in Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 579, Subpart B - Reporting of Safety Recalls and Other Safety Campaigns in Foreign Countries.

1. Name of Manufacturer

Suzuki Motor Corporation ("Suzuki")

2. Identification of Motor Vehicles Involved

Affected vehicles are 2006-2011 Suzuki Grand Vitara multipurpose passenger vehicles and 2007-2011 Suzuki SX4 passenger cars sold in the countries identified below.

4. Description of Condition

Under certain conditions, repeated stress to the sensor mat of the occupant sensing system can cause an open circuit. This will cause the front passenger frontal air bag to remain active regardless of the weight of the front seat occupant. The air bag warning light in the instrument cluster and the front passenger's seat belt reminder light will be illuminated and the PASS AIR BAG OFF indicator will remain off.

5. Identification of Campaign Initiator, Campaign Type, and Program for Remediating Defect

This campaign is being initiated by Suzuki as a Warranty Extension Campaign. Affected vehicles will receive extended warranty coverage for 10 years or 120,000 miles for the condition described above.

6. Identification of Determination Date, Foreign Countries Involved, and Campaign Commencement Dates

Suzuki decided on April 18, 2012 to conduct a Warranty Extension Campaign in the countries identified below (applicable countries are identified separately for the SX4 and Grand Vitara models) and the U.S. The campaign will commence on April 18, 2012.

SX4 - Lebanon, Iceland, Canada, Guatemala, Chile

Grand Vitara - Taiwan, Iceland, Netherlands, Germany, Switzerland, Hungary, Ukraine, Canada, Uruguay

7. Identification of "Substantially Similar"¹ Vehicles Sold or Offered for Sale in the U.S.

2006-2011 Suzuki Grand Vitara
2007-2011 Suzuki SX4
