**REPORT OF A SAFETY RECALL OR OTHER SAFETY CAMPAIGN

No vehicles sold in the United States are affected because they do not use the subject brake master cylinder as discussed below.

3. Total Number of Vehicles Potentially Involved

Approximately 73,961.

Nissan Micra vehicles; Approximately 29,441.

Nissan Sunny vehicles; Approximately 37,504

Renault Pulse vehicles; Approximately 2,836.

Renault Scara vehicles; Approximately 4,180.

4. Description of the Defect

The brake master cylinder plunger may not meet the surface roughness specification, increasing friction and preventing the plunger from sliding smoothly through the seal. The increased friction causes the seal to twist. If the braking system is operated under low pressure while experiencing this condition, the customer may experience longer brake pedal travel and the brake force may be lower than expected, resulting in reduced braking performance.

9. Descriptive of Corrective Action

Owners of potentially affected vehicles will be notified to take their vehicle to a dealer. The brake master cylinder will be replaced with a counter-measured one. The brake fluid will be replaced as part of this process.

10. Vehicles in the United States (If known)

Model year 2012-2013 Nissan Versa Sedan vehicles sold in the U.S. are on a similar "platform" as the Nissan Micra vehicles and Nissan Sunny vehicles sold in above countries. However, these U.S. vehicles are not identical or substantially similar from an engineering standpoint. As noted above, this issue affects no vehicles sold in the U.S.
