
Number of Vehicles Affected: Volkswagen is adding approximately 10,629 vehicles to this recall, bringing the total affected number of vehicles to approximately 18,187 affected in Canada. Volkswagen is also removing 33 gasoline engine Passat vehicles from this recall, because it was determined that those vehicles were not built with an engine block heater.

Basis for Determination: Field data analysis

Reason U.S. Vehicles Are Not Affected: The factory-installed engine block heater affected by this recall is not available in vehicles manufactured for the U.S. market.

- (4) Description of Defective Component(s) and Manufacturer
Engine block heater, manufactured by Calix
- (5) Total Number of Vehicles Affected
Approximately 18,187 vehicles in Canada only
- (6) Description of Defect
The factory-installed engine block heater could overheat during use, resulting in a possible fire.
- (7) Affected Countries
Canada
- (8) Type of Campaign
Safety recall
- (9) Determination made by:

- (10) Manufacturers Program of Remedy
Inspect and, if necessary, replace the engine block heater.
