

**REPORT OF A SAFETY RECALL OR OTHER SAFETY CAMPAIGN
IN A FOREIGN COUNTRY**

1. Manufacturer

Nissan Motor Company, Ltd., Japan.

2. Vehicles Potentially Involved

Nissan NV200 VANETTE vehicles produced from September 13, 2014 to September 17, 2014 at Nissan Shatai Co., Ltd., Shonan plant in Japan. No vehicles sold in the United States are affected because they use a different brake master cylinder than the affected vehicles.

3. Total Number of Vehicles Potentially Involved

Approximately 27.

4. Description of the Defect

For the affected vehicles, the checking fixture for another product was accidentally used during the inspection stage in the manufacturing process of the brake master cylinder. This could cause an excessive load to be applied to the installation flange of the master cylinder and may cause the flange to crack. Once installed in a vehicle and driven for a period of time, the crack can grow and the flange may ultimately break. If the flange breaks it may result in degraded braking performance.

5. Foreign Country in which the Safety Recall or Other Safety Campaign is Being Conducted

Japan.

9. Descriptive of Corrective Action

Owners of potentially affected vehicles will be notified to take their vehicle to a dealer and the brake master cylinder will be replaced.

10. Vehicles in the United States (If known)

Model year 2013-2014 Nissan NV200 vehicles, model year 2007-2013 Nissan Versa Hatchback vehicles and model year 2007-2011 Nissan Versa Sedan vehicles sold in the U.S. are on a similar "platform" as the Nissan NV200 VANETTE vehicles sold in Japan. However, these U.S. vehicles are not identical or substantially similar from an engineering standpoint. As noted above, this issue affects no vehicles sold in the U.S.
