Re: Foreign Recall Report

Dear Mr. Rea,

On June 3, 2016 Honda Motor Co., Ltd. (HMC) decided to launch the first phase of recalling all Takata non-desiccated passenger frontal airbag inflators (SPI, PSPI, PSPI-L, and PSPI-6) installed in certain vehicles built from CY2008 and earlier in Japan.

As prescribed by Japan's Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transportation and Tourism's official schedule, on September 1, 2016 HMC decided to launch the second phase of recalling all Takata non-desiccated passenger frontal airbag inflators installed in certain vehicles built from CY2011 and earlier, including certain MY2012 vehicles.

According to the Amendment to the November 3, 2015 Consent Order, the Defect Information Report to recall certain MY2012 vehicles located in Zone A in the United States and installed with Takata non-desiccated passenger frontal airbag inflators is scheduled for December 31, 2016.

Since the recall of certain 2012MY vehicles located in Zone A in the United States is not expected to begin until CY2017, the following information is submitted pursuant to the requirements of 49 CFR 579.12 for the MY2012 vehicles that are now under recall in Japan in accordance with the September 1, 2016 action.

Description of the Basis for the Determination of the Recall Population:

The recall population was determined based on manufacturing records.

Total Number of Vehicles Potentially Affected: 668,816

Defect Description:

Specifically, in some vehicles, the passenger frontal airbag inflator could produce excessive internal pressure upon deployment. If an affected airbag deploys, the increased internal pressure may cause the inflator to rupture (break apart) and deploy abnormally. In the

event of an inflator rupture, metal fragments could pass through the airbag cushion material possibly causing serious injury or fatality to vehicle occupants.


