Foreign Safety Recall / Other Safety Campaign Report

Subject: Sliding door latch issue on certain Toyota vehicles

1. Vehicle Manufacturer Name:

Toyota Motor Manufacturing, Indiana, Inc. ["TMMI"]

2. Involved Vehicles:

3. Substantially Similar Vehicles sold in the U.S.:

Model Year/ Make/ Car Line: 2011-2016 Model Year Toyota Sienna

4. Description of Problem:

The subject vehicles are equipped with sliding side doors which are secured by front and rear latches. Due to corrosion caused by water intrusion, the door may not fully latch or may prevent the power sliding door from closing. Should this condition occur, it would be visible as well as be indicated by the "Door Ajar" telltale lamp or multi-information display, and a warning chime would sound. Doors equipped with a power sliding door also have an additional warning buzzer. Because these methods of warning exist, an unreasonable safety risk is not presented.

5. Description of Corrective Repair Action:

Owners will be notified that Toyota is extending the warranty on the sliding door latches in the subject vehicles from 3 years / 60,000km or 100,000km to 9 years / unlimited mileage. If a customer presents the vehicle to a dealer within the extended warranty period, the dealer will inspect the sliding door latches and replace the front and/or rear latch assemblies with improved ones.

6. Determination to Conduct Safety Recall / Other Safety Campaign:

- The determination was made by Toyota Motor Corporation;
- Date of determination : December 9, 2016
- Date campaign will commence : As soon as remedy is available

7. Reason the similar vehicles sold in the U.S. are not involved in this safety recall / other safety campaign:

Toyota will conduct the same action (Warranty Extension) for 2011 – 2016 MY Toyota Sienna vehicles sold in the U.S. as in Canada and the other countries for certain 2011-2016 Toyota Sienna vehicles to alleviate potential customer inconvenience posed by this issue. This condition does not present an unreasonable risk to safety, because there are indicators which would make a driver aware of a door that is not fully latched.
