Foreign Safety Recall / Other Safety Campaign Report

Subject: Front Passenger Air Bag issue on certain Toyota Corolla Rumion Vehicles

1. Vehicle Manufacturer Name:

Toyota Motor Corporation ["TMC"]

2. Involved Vehicles:

3. Substantially Similar Vehicles sold in the U.S.:

Model Year/ Make/ Car Line: 2008-2011 Model Year Toyota Scion xB, RAV4

4. Description of Problem:

The subject vehicles are equipped with a front passenger air bag assembly which contains a single-stage inflator (Takata-designated SPI-2). During the vehicle assembly process, there is a possibility that air bag assemblies with a different type of inflator (Takata-designated PSPI-6) may have been installed in some vehicles. This could result in deployment of the front passenger air bag in a manner other than as designed, increasing the risk of injury to a front seat passenger.

5. Description of Corrective Repair Action:

For all involved vehicles, the dealer will replace the front passenger air bag assembly with a new one.

6. Determination to Conduct Safety Recall / Other Safety Campaign:

- The determination was made by Toyota Motor Corporation;
- Date of determination : February 13, 2017;
- Date campaign will commence : As soon as the remedy parts are available

7. Reason the similar vehicles sold in the U.S. are not involved in this safety recall / other safety campaign:

This issue only affects Toyota Corolla Rumion vehicles produced in Japan with an incorrect air bag assembly. None of these vehicles have been exported to or sold in the U.S.
