**Foreign Safety Recall / Other Safety Campaign Report**

Subject: Windshield and/or rear window issue on certain Toyota Corolla and Vios vehicles

4. Description of Problem:

The windshield and/or rear window on the affected vehicles may have been installed without primer, potentially reducing the glass bonding strength. Overtime, the glass bonding strength may be reduced to a point at which the windshield or rear window could detach while driving, becoming an obstacle to other drivers and increasing the risk of a crash.

5. Description of Corrective Repair Action:

For all involved vehicles, dealers will inspect the windshield and rear window, and, if necessary, reinstall them correctly.

6. Determination to Conduct Safety Recall / Other Safety Campaign:

- The determination was made by Toyota Motor Corporation;
- Date of determination : July 6, 2018
- Date campaign will commence : Late July 2018

7. Reason the similar vehicles sold in the U.S. are not involved in this safety recall / other safety campaign:

This issue only affects the above mentioned Toyota Corolla and Vios vehicles produced at TFTM during the production period indicated above. Substantially similar vehicles currently sold in the U.S. were not built at this plant. None of the involved vehicles have been exported to or sold in the U.S.
