

REASON FOR THIS FIELD ACTION

All Transit vehicles were configured with one-sided parking light functionality enabled. Because of this, some Transit vehicles did not meet the European parking lights regulation ECE R48-08, 6.12 which prohibits single sided parking light activation for vehicles longer than 6m and wider than 2m.
