In accordance with your August 29, 2002 request, Cunningham Investigative Services Fire Analysis Specialist Kevin T. Cunningham visited the Greenville, South Carolina area on September 3, 2002 to investigate the above captioned fire loss. The purpose of the investigation was to determine the origin and cause of the fire. This letter will serve as a preliminary report.

A visual and photographic inspection of the fire-damaged structure was conducted; debris was not disturbed; a non scale schematic was drawn; and informal interviews were conducted with Mr. Frances Cote and Investigator Michael Hawkins of EFI, who was representing Harleysville Insurance Company, the insurance carrier for Malden Road Tire & Service.

The fire-damaged structure was a one-story, wood frame and brick veneer, single family dwelling built on a closed crawl space. The structure was protected from the elements by a pitched, composite shingled roof. The structure was serviced by electricity provided by Duke Energy, natural gas provided by Picciment Gas, water and telephone. The electrical service entered through the carport on the east side of the structure. The natural gas service entered on the west side of the structure. For reference purposes the structure is considered as facing south. The physical location of the structure is Latitude North 34° 45.819' and Longitude West 082° 18.032'. The structure was normal for the area where it was located and the exterior of the structure was in good condition.

Close inspection revealed that the fire originated in the carport on the east end of the structure. The burn patterns revealed that the fire originated in the engine compartment of a 1993 Lincoln Town

Car, Vehicle Education Number of 1LNLM82W9PY668808, in the west side of the curport at the east end of the structure. A copy of the photographs taken at the time of this inspection showing the burn patterns and the amount of damage to the structure are enclosed for review.

Mr. Frances Cote stated that Malden Read Tire & Service worked on the 1993 Lincoln Town Car on the day of the fire. He stated that after he got the vehicle back from them, he drove it on an 18-mile trip to town. He stated that the vehicle statled approximately six times on the way to town. He stated that he had called the owner of Malden Tire and advised him of the problem. He stated that he returned home and a short time later the fire was discovered in the vehicle. Copies of the work orders from Malden Tire were obtained from Mr. Cote and are enclosed for review.

Investigator Michael Hawkins stated that he visited the scene and determined that the fire originated in the 1993 Lincoln Town Car. Since that time the vehicle has been transported to the Logarville, Georgia area in anticipation of a close inspection to determine the exact cause of the fire. Mr. Dave Hosenic of USAA has contacted Ford Motor Company in an attempt for their representative to be present for this inspection.

The photographs taken at the time of this inspection, a non scale schematic drawing of the structure, and a copy of the work orders obtained from Mr. Cote are enclosed with this report.

Based upon the observations and investigation to date, it is the opinion of Cunningham investigative Services that the fire originated in the 1993 Lincoln Town Car in the west side of the carport at the cast end of the structure. It is further the opinion of Cunningham Investigative Services that the exact cause of the fire will be determined at a later date when all interested parties can be present for a close impection of the vehicle.
