Please be advised that I have been retained by State Farm Fire & Casualty Company and State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company, in connection with damages sustained as a result of a fire which occurred on Jamus Car and the residential dwelling owned by State Farms' insured substantial property damage totaling approximately \$177,010.86.

According to our expert's report, the fire originated in the 1994 Lincoln Town Car that was parked inside the garage of the above mentioned residential dwelling. The fire was caused by a defect in the electrical wiring which resulted in a short-circuit and ignition of nearby combustibles.

ABSKINMENT

The assignment was received Wednesday, January 27, 1999, from Mr. Karl Landry, with instructions to conduct an Origin and Cause Fire Investigation. The fire occurred Wednesday, January 27, 1999, at approximately 2:30 P.M. The investigation into the origin and cause of this fire was commenced Friday, January 29, 1999.

DESCRIPTION OF INSURED PROPERTY

The dwelling was a one story, owner occupied, brick veneer construction. It was built on a concrete slab foundation with a composition shingle roof. This house was hested and air conditioned with a central electric unit. The electricity to the all electric house was connected and operational at the time the fire occurred. This dwelling was in good condition before the fire occurred. It was built in 1974 and is located near Daville, Louisiana. Fire protection for the area is from the Daville Volunteer Fire Department with the Holiday Village sub-station being the closest.

DESCRIPTION OF VEHICLE

The vehicle which was also destroyed in the fire was a 1994 Lincoln 4 door Sedan with Louisianta license plate number the little of the powered with a V8 engine and automatic transmission. The vehicle was purchased as a program car with approximately 19,000 miles and at the time of the fire, it had approximately 80,000 miles.

FIRE SCENE BXAMINATION

A fire scene was conducted Friday, January 29, 1999, starting at 9:00 A.M. The scene was photographed, measured and a field diagram was drawn. The scene had not received significant alterations since the

occurrence of the fire, therefore enabling an accurate fire cause determination. A survey of the perimeter did not show any evidence of an explosion in connection with this fire. When the fire was at home when the fire occurred and there was no forced entry prior to or during the fire. A survey of the demage revealed the garage had been totally gutted by the fire and the roof was burned off. The entire dwelling including the attic received very extensive fire destruction. A 1994 Lincoln 4 door Sedan which was parked in the garage, also received what would be considered total fire destruction.

A visual inventory of the contents indicated there was an average amount located in this dwelling. These contents appeared to have been of good quality and in good condition before the fire occurred. The contents within the north end of the dwelling received near total destruction from the fire and the heat. The contents which were located within the south end of the dwelling received very extensive destruction from the fire, heat and smoke.

A study was undertaken to establish the origin and cause of this fire. A comparative analysis of the heat and burn pattern revealed a zone of concentrated burning within the marage. This is the location where the firehad been burning for the longest period of time. It was further verified by I that this was the location of the fire at the time of discovery. Closer examination revealed that the deepest scated burning was in the vehicle which was parked in the garage. The thermal discoloration and distortion to the vehicle hidicate the fire had originated within the vehicle and had extended to the garage area. The engine compartment, passenger compartment and trunk area were examined. It was established that the fire had originated within the passenger compartment and had extended to the engine compartment and trunk area. The electrical wiring throughout this Lincoln 4 door Seden was closely examined. The electrical wiring within the center portion of the dash was fused and beaded. There were unmerous copper beads recovered from this area. These conditions are consistent with results of an electrical short circuit or an electrical malfunction. It is my professional opinion, that an electrical short circuit occurred within one of the

wiring harnesses near the center of the dash. The insulation on the wiring and the surrounding combustible materials were ignited by the heat and sparks from the short circuit. The ensuing fire traveled throughout the passenger compartment, entered the engine compartment and trunk area causing what would be considered total fire destruction to this vehicle. This fire aceas, examination and investigation did not establish any other reasonable cause for this fire. There was no evidence whatsoever, which would indicate the cause of the fire was incendiary in nature.

SUMMARY REPORT OF INVESTIGATION

It was learned in an interview with the discovered the fire at approximately 2:00 A.M., Wednesday, January 27, 1999. She was sleeping in the master bodroom when she heard popping and heard the doorbell ringing. She turned on all the lights from her bedroom to the utility room on the opposite end of the dwelling. She went to the utility room door which opens into the garage. When she opened the door, there was a wall of flames coming up from the Lincoln 4 door Sedan. She ran to her neighbors house and asked them to call 9-1-1. She went back to her dwelling and her Lincoln 4 Door Sedan was totally on fire and the flames were rolling up across the ceiling coming out through the garage door. The Devilla Volunteer fire Department responded to the alarm. By the time they could control and notinguish the fire the vehicle had received total fire destruction. The garage was totally destroyed and the fire had extended throughout the majority of the dwelling. By that time, the majority of the roof had been consumed by the blaze.

CONCLUSION

In conclusion, it is my professional opinion this fire originated within this 1994 Lincoln 4 Door Sedan. The fire was caused by an electrical short circuit or malfunction in the wiring harness near the center of the dash. This fire some examination and investigation did not establish any other reasonable cause for this fire.
