Summary: ODI has received 37 reports from consumers alleging that brake lamps are not working when the brake pedal is depressed. The subject vehicles have one brake lamp each in the left and right rear tail lamp assembly and a center high mounted stop lamp. Reports allege that the brake lamp in the tail lamp assembly (left, right or both) is failing. In some cases, repeat failures occur after replacing failed brake lamp bulb. A preliminary evaluation has been opened to determine if a safety defect trend exists.
