Summary: ODI has received nine complaints alleging that the transmission spontaneously shifted into reverse after the driver had placed the gearshift lever in the park position with the engine running. Four of the incidents involved allegations of "unintended vehicle movement" occurring after the driver had fully exited the vehicle. One such event resulted in the vehicle reversing and pinning the operator against a garage wall with its rear bumper. The subject vehicles are equipped with shift mechanisms mounted on the steering column and an electric "PRNDL" (gear position indicator). A preliminary evaluation has been opened.
