Summary: General Motors is conducting Recall Campaign 04V-129 to replace the tailgate support cables originally installed in certain model year 2000-2004 Sierras and Silverados and model year 2002-2004 Avalanches and Cadillac Escalade EXTs.

ODI has reviewed owner complaints and GM warranty information for 1998 and 1999 model year Sierras and Silverados and compared this data with comparable complaint and warranty information pertaining to 2000-2004 model year vehicles. The data indicates that tailgate cable breakage incidents and injuries have occurred in 1998-1999 model year Sierras and Silverados, but these incidents occur at a lower count and lower rate than 2000-2004 model year Sierras and Silverados.

ODI will conduct further investigation to determine whether further action is indicated for 1998-1999 model year Sierras and Silverados.
