ASSIGNMENT DETAILS

This assignment was received on May 12, 2004 from Aziza Syed-Calandrella of State Farm Insurance Company. My instructions were to conduct an origin and cause examination of the vehicle fire loss in Spring City, Pennsylvania. My investigation commenced on May 17, 2004.

VEHICLE DESCRIPTION

The vehicle involved in this fire loss is a 2000 Ford F150-XLT Tritun pickup track. An 8-cylinder engine powered the vehicle and it was equipped with an automatic transmission. The VIN was verified as 1FTRX18L8YN The Pennsylvania license plate number was YSN-4894 and had a 12/04-expiration date. The Pennsylvania State Inspection sticker was dated 12/04. The vehicle was in good condition prior to the fire, but I could not determine the mileage.

VEHICLE EXAMINATION

My examination of the vehicle was conducted on May 17, 2004 at Morroni's Auto Body Shop, in West Chester, PA. Other than the vehicle being moved from the location where the fire occurred, there were not any obvious signs of the vehicle having been altered since the date of the loss.

In examining the exterior of the vehicle, the only location I found any signs of fire damage was on the hood near the windshield on the driver's side, and also the plastic material between the hood and the windshield. There was also some minor damage just out from the front, left wheel well. The front left tire was slightly burned, but was still holding air. The remainder of the vehicle was undamaged by the fire.

VEHICLE EXAMINATION (cont.)

The only fire damage to the underside of the vehicle was in the front, left wheel well area where the plastic was melted and burned out. None of the glass for the vehicle was burned, although there was some minor soot on the exterior of the glass near the bottom on the driver's side. The extended cab window on the left side was broken out, possibly by the fire officials to gain access to the interior. There were no other signs of forced entry into the vehicle.

I did not find any damage in the interior of the vehicle, although I could not be certain that a small amount of heat may have caused some damage after heat impinged on the firewall from the engine compartment.

Fire damage was found in the engine compartment, although it was limited. The radiator, radiator hoses, and drive belts were unburned. Some other hoses had some heat damage. The fan and shroud were unburned and only the left inner fender was burned. All of the fluids were at a normal level and did not show anything unusual. The heaviest damage was on the left or driver's side in the center between the front and rear of the compartment.

The wiring harness was burned in the engine compartment on the left side, and the fuse panel in the engine compartment was slightly distorted from the heat. All of this damage was fimited. There was nothing to indicate the fire started from any type of fuel or other fluid leaks. The air intake filters and the fuel vapor recovery system had some slight heat damage, but this was also limited.

A closer examination of the engine compartment revealed the damage extended outward from the area around the brake master cylinder, and there was also some drop down-type burning that occurred below this. I did not find anything below this area that could have caused this fire. I found an electrical connection at the master cylinder where a wire was connected to it. This electrical connection is a pressure switch that activates and deactivates the cruise control when pressure is applied to the brake.

The electrical wire leading to this switch was void of the insulation but showed no signs of electrical arcing. The switch was damaged internally, with some small copper beads that had formed sitting in the top of the master cylinder connection. There was also electrical activity and burning inside the switch in a fashion that was inconsistent with a fire impinging on it from the exterior.

VEHICLE EXAMINATION (cont.)

It was clearly obvious that something occurred within this switch and caused this fire. The internal parts actually would have been protected since there were still exterior components existing.

I did not find any other signs of electrical arcing, or any other possible causes to this fire. There was also nothing suspicious about it.

COMMENTS

It is my opinion this fire is accidental and started at the pressure switch on the master eylinder. This was an electrical fire that did not gain much intensity before it was discovered and extinguished. The remains of the switch with the wire, which was still connected to the truck, along with the master cylinder, were left intact with the vehicle at the shop.

Since I have complied with all of the instructions on this file, it will now be closed. Use files are maintained for a period of time and can easily be reopened if needed.

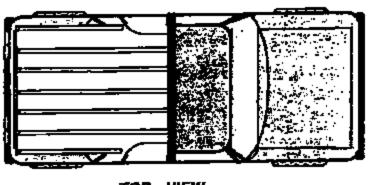

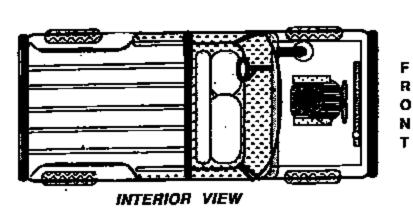
