

Dear Sirs;

This letter and enclosure (Letter to Michael Packard with carbon copy to Stephen McHenry) is hereby submitted to NHTSA in support of NVS-213 / EA05-021 regarding the Electronic Throttle Module (ETM.)

The information being submitted is considered by Volvo to be confidential, and an affidavit to support that claim is enclosed.

We firmly believe that the release of this confidential information would compromise Volvo's position and make public Volvo proprietary information that could cause competitive harm to Volvo Car Corporation and to Volvo Cars North America, LLC (Volvo).

• This specific information has never been released to the public and there is no intention to release this to the public.

• Public release of this information could lead to misuse of this information. Misuse of this information includes the possibility of unauthorized tampering with Volvo's vehicle systems and making Volvo proprietary technology available to Volvo's competition. This could cause substantial competitive harm to Volvo.

Therefore we request that the confidential information be treated within the meaning of confidential business information pursuant to 5USC 552(b)(4) and Section 112(e) of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1966 as amended and implemented in 49 CFR Part 512.

In accordance with 49 CFR 512.4(a)(4), we are submitting one (1) copy of each of the above documents to your office containing the confidential information, and one (1) copy of each of the above documents to your office with the confidential information omitted.

Also, in accordance with 49 CFR 512.4(a)(1), each page containing confidential information has been marked "confidential", and in accordance with 49 CFR 512.4(a)(2), each item of confidential information has been placed within brackets "[]".
