Summary: The Office Of Defects Investigation has received 10 reports that allege loss of brake power-assist resulting in increased pedal effort required to stop or slow the vehicle, or other brake system performance related complaint where the vacuum brake booster assembly was replaced to remedy the complainant's concern. Some complainants allege that the brake master cylinder assembly was also replaced during service repairs.

A Preliminary Evaluation has been opened to assess the scope and safety consequences of the alleged defect.
