Summary: ODI has received three consumer complaints of front coil spring breakage in subject vehicles. In two of these instances the broken spring came into contact with a tire. ODI has also received EWR information relating to a coil spring failure causing tire damage. A Preliminary Evaluation has been opened to determine the scope, frequency and safety consequences associated with the alleged defect.
