Summary: The Office of Defects Investigation (ODI) has received three complaints alleging that large quantities of gasoline leaks from the fuel tank. One complainant alleged that immediately after fill-up, a large quantity of gasoline leaked from the fuel tank (not from the filler pipe). Two other complainants discovered that the day after the tank was filled their garage floor was flooded with gasoline.

A Preliminary Evaluation has been opened to assess the safety-related consequences and to determine the scope of the affected population.
