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Summary: The Office of Defects Investigation (ODI) has received two consumer complaints alleging that an original equipment front five-spoke wheel separated without any warning with all five spokes breaking near the wheel hub. No vehicle crash occurred prior to, or after the wheel separation as a result of loss of control.

One of the complainants indicated that their wheel separation resulted in a traffic collision involving a law enforcement officer who was driving a motorcycle on the opposite side of the freeway. His motorcycle was struck by the separated wheel causing a crash and serious injury.

Wheel separation may result in loss of vehicle control. The separated wheel/tire could strike another vehicle or a pedestrian and is a road hazard.

A Preliminary Evaluation has been opened to assess the safety-related consequences and to determine the scope of the affected population.
