Summary: Following our opening of this PE and subsequent discussions with Triumph Motorcycles LTD, the company decided to launch a safety-related recall campaign of all Rocket III model motorcycles to address occurrences of sudden and unforeseen tip-out stalling. This action was taken in lieu of responding to NHTSA/ODI's June 25th information request and involves the installation of an upgraded ECU incorporating revised engine management software.

With Triumph's safety-related recall, this PE is closed.
