Summary: ODI has received reports of 19 incidents in which fires have occurred in the subject vehicles. The fires have reportedly occurred in the engine compartment, the interior instrument panel/console area, and the vehicle undercarriage in the vicinity of the catalytic converter. The incidents are alleged to result from failure or malfunction of the ignition coils in vehicles equipped with four- and six-cylinder gasoline powered engines.

A Preliminary Evaluation has been opened to assess the matter.
