Summary: ODI has received 9 complaints from consumers indicating that while driving their vehicles, their instrument cluster would exhibit a temporary on/off condition where the gauges would drop to zero, warning lights would illuminate, and turn signal telltale would not operate. One complainant verified a no turn signal condition by looking at the turn signal bulbs not illuminating outside of the vehicle.

Ford Motor Company issued a TSB on August of 2006 indicating that some of the subject vehicles built before February 17, 2006, may exhibit intermittent instrument cluster concerns. ODI is opening this PE to further evaluate this issue.
