Dear Mr. Cooper:

This responds to your letter dated July 27, 2007, which requests certain information to aid in the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's investigation of allegations of headlight failures in Suzuki Forenza vehicles.

As we discussed by telephone, GM Daewoo Auto & Technology Company (GMDAT), the manufacturer of Suzuki Forenza vehicles sold in the U.S., has decided to conduct a safety-related recall campaign to address this problem. The recall will include all of the vehicles identified as "subject vehicles" in your information request. In addition, American Suzuki Motor Corporation (ASMC) is providing the information below, which you have agreed will serve as ASMC's complete response to your July 27, 2007 information request.

1. The number of subject vehicles (2004-2005 Suzuki Forenzas) produced by GMDAT for sale in the U.S. by ASMC is 58,448 vehicles.
2. ASMC has identified 23 consumer complaints, 186 field reports (including dealer field reports), and 1,855 warranty claims which may relate to the alleged defect in the subject vehicles.
3. ASMC has not received any lawsuits, claims or notices involving injury or death, or property damage claims


