## Summary:

ODI has received 10 complaints of fuel leaking from Model Year 2002-2003 4Motion (AWD) 6-cylinder VW Passats. The complainants were alerted by the strong smell of gasoline, usually when the tank was more than half full. Some complainants also found leaking gasoline dripping under the car. Two complainants specified gas leaking at approximately 20 drops per minute.

The leaks appear to occur when one of the three plastic vent valves (nipples) on the top of the fuel tank cracks. Both the tank and the vent valves are made of plastic. Complainants report that the repair required replacing the fuel tank.
