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Summary: The Office of Defects Investigation (ODI) has received 7 complaints from consumers residing in "salt belt" states that allege front suspension coil spring fracture in the subject vehicles. (Note: for purposes of this investigation, the "salt belt" includes Connecticut, Delaware, the District of Columbia, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Maine, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Vermont, West Virginia and Wisconsin). Four of the seven complaints allege the broken coil spring punctured the adjacent tire resulting in loss of inflation pressure. Two complaints allege that both front suspension coil springs fractured and required replacement. No crashes or injuries have been reported.

A Preliminary Evaluation has been opened to assess the frequency, scope and safety consequences of the alleged defect.
