Summary:

ODI has received 27 complaints reporting loss of bulb function for one or more of the following: front parking, front turn signal, daytime running lights (DRL), rear stop, rear turn signal, or tail lamps. In response to customer concerns reporting inoperative bulb function, GM has issued a Technical Service Bulletin (#06-08-42-004B) describing a procedure for removing and replacing a bulb with a specific brand name and type bulb, inspecting the bulb sockets for discoloration and, if necessary, replacing the bulb socket. ODI is opening this PE to further evaluate this issue.
