## Summary:

The Office of Defects Investigation has received 11 complaints alleging vehicle rollaways after the complainant shifted the vehicle into park. Eight of the complaints allege a crash occurred as a result of the rollaway incident. Four complainants allege injuries after being struck by the vehicle during the rollaway incident.

In addition to the 11 complainants alleging vehicle rollaway incidents, 61 complainants have also alleged failure of gear shift lever mechanism while shifting from or to the park position.

A Preliminary Evaluation has been opened to assess the scope, frequency and potential safety consequences of the alleged defect and any relationship of the alleged gearshift lever mechanism failures to the alleged vehicle rollaway incidents.
