Summary:

ODI has received a vehicle owner questionnaire alleging a large transmission fluid leak shortly after vehicle purchase, with just 47 miles of service. Based on a dealer inspection, the leak was from a cut in the hose that carries automatic transmission fluid to the ATF cooler caused by contact from the radiator cooling fan. The complaint alleges that the failure resulted in a loss of motive power and presented a risk of fire. ODI also identified field report data related to the alleged defect in Early Warning information submitted by Volkswagen. A Preliminary Evaluation has been opened to assess the frequency and safety consequences of the alleged defect.
