Action: Open this Defect Petition.

Summary:

The Office of Defects Investigation (ODI) received a defect petition requesting that it open an investigation of model year (MY) 2008 Toyota Corolla vehicles for the failure of the frontal air bags to deploy during a serious crash. The petitioner alleges that the frontal air bags in their MY 2008 Corolla failed to deploy during a 55-mph frontal impact with a large animal (a deer). During this crash neither the driver nor front passenger was seriously injured in the incident, according to the statements the petitioner provided. The petitioner also filed a complaint with the agency (see ODI 10327470 for further details of the incident and the petition submitted to the agency).

ODI will evaluate the defect petition for a grant or deny decision. The analysis will focus primarily on complaints of air bag non-deployment on MY 2008 Corolla and peer vehicles reported to the agency as well as other crash data available from databases NHTSA maintains.
