Mr. Yon,

EA11-010 was issued to further investigate allegations of headlight malfunction in 2005-2007 minivans. This document was issued on December 27, 2011 and included a submission due date February 24, 2012.

The scope of work has been substantially increased relative to the Preliminary Evaluation, PE10-022, in terms of Suspect and Peer population, number of components implied in the alleged defect statement, and assessment requirements.

Chrysler is prepared to submit response to Questions 1 through 8, and Question 15 in accordance with the required submission date of February 24, 2012.

However, Chrysler would like to request a four (4) week extension to March 23, 2012 for submission of the response to the remaining questions.
