Dear Mr. Vincent:

Enclosed with this letter are three copies of General Motors' (GM) February 18, 2013, voluntary response to the NHTSA's information request (IR) received on December 20, 2012, requesting GM peer vehicle data to assist in your investigation of allegations of crash related fire hazards associated with the fuel storage systems on model year (MY) 1993-2004 Jeep Grand Cherokee, MY 1993-2001 Jeep Cherokee, and MY 2002-2007 Jeep Liberty vehicles.

Two copies include the confidential documents and the third does not.

GM understands that there is no alleged defect with respect to any of its vehicles and is providing this information voluntarily as part of the agency's investigation of another manufacturer's vehicles.

GM requests that the documents stamped "GM Confidential Business Information" included in ATT_2_GM_CONF disk be afforded confidential treatment without a time limitation by the NHTSA. This information is voluntarily submitted and is the kind of information that is customarily not released to the public by General Motors and contains trade secrets and commercial information which is privileged or confidential under 5 U.S.C. Section 552(b)(4), 49 CFR Part 512 and 49 U.S.C. Section 30167(a).

The following identifies the specific type of confidential information contained in the documents:

Documents in response to Q_05 and Q_06 on the ATT_2_GM_CONF disk identified above disclose information about GM's application of engineering judgment, analysis, methodologies and action. This information would give competitors insight into GM's methodologies and disclose confidential information about the design and performance of its products, without spending their own resources or compensating GM for the knowledge they would gain.

GM treats the above material as confidential proprietary information available only to authorized GM, supplier and customer personnel who have a business need for it, and it is not otherwise available to the public. These documents are maintained under a record-keeping system that is intended to control dissemination of this material within GM and supplier and customer personnel, and to assure that it is not freely disseminated outside the Corporation.

To the best of our knowledge, no prior determinations of the confidentiality of the documents submitted with this request have been made by the NHTSA, other Federal Agencies or the Federal Courts. Documents such as those containing engineering testing procedures have normally been granted confidential treatment by the NHTSA in the past.

The document subject to this request for confidentiality are being provided and have been clearly stamped "GM Confidential Business Information" on the disk label. If a request for disclosure of any or all of this information is received by the NHTSA, General Motors requests notification of receipt of each such request and, if necessary, an opportunity to further explain the reasons why such material is trade secret and commercial information which should not be disclosed under the applicable statutes and regulations.
