

MEMO TO FILE FOR DEFECTS PETITION REGARDING
MY 2005 HONDA PILOT ELECTRONIC STABILITY CONTROL MALFUNCTION

In the Petition associated with VOQ 10366406 petitioner Carrie Carvalho states, "NHTSA itself has at least 38 solid complaints," referring to her petition request that NHTSA "initiate a defect investigation into 2005 Honda Pilots for defective Electronic Stability Control Systems." ODI is only associating 35 with the opening of the defects petition investigation. The following VOQs cited by the petitioner are not associated with the opening of the investigation for the following reasons:

10321747	Complainant lives in a foreign country
10314400	Action of vehicle involves avoidance maneuver which normally induces ESC and a comment that her brake wasn't working properly: attempting to acquire more information. Cannot categorize at this time. May or may not be related.
10281800	Duplicate to 10282189 which is already associated
10259544	Duplicate to 10260943 which is already associated
10189816	Complainant states transmission repair corrected problem with a braking-Loss Of Motive Power issue. After trans repair it appears to read that there is an alignment issue with a pulling condition: attempting to acquire more information. Cannot categorize at this time. May or may not be related.
10158376	Crash: begins with driver applying brakes and vehicle not slowing down: inconsistent with issue under discussion: attempting to acquire more information. Cannot categorize at this time. May or may not be related.
