I am writing to you on behalf of myself and my company, to express our extreme dissatisfaction with your company in regards to the handling of what we consider a very serious safety problem with a Chrysler motor vehicle which I currently drive. Pertinent information is as follows:

The incident I am referring to was the malfunctioning airbag system and non-required deployment of both airbags which occurred on June 27, 2002 while I was driving the vehicle to Chicago O'Hare International Airport to pick up a personal visitor who was arriving from Ireland that afternoon. At approximately 11:30 a.m. while traveling in the middle lane of three Southbound lanes during heavy traffic, the warning light and audible warning went off signaling a problem with the vehicle's airbag system. I was boxed in by traffic, including a semi-trailer on my immediate right, which blocked me from getting to the side of the road. I immediately reached for the vehicle information booklet while holding on to the steering wheel with my left hand alone. Within the next 10 to 15 seconds, the interior of the vehicle filled with the smell of burning circuitry and the driver's side steering wheel airbag deployed with an extremely loud explosion, forcing my right hand backwards

a few seconds, the passenger side front airbag also exploded and deployed, with two of the vent direction covers blowing out and flying through the interior of the vehicle and a portion of the lower dashboard being torn from the dash.

I will assure you that the explosions and deployment of the airbags while driving 65 miles per hour in the middle of traffic were quite unnerving, causing me to jerk my head violently in reaction. In what I can only describe as pure luck, I was able to push the inflated driver's airbag out of my line of vision as it deflated and head to the side of the road to pull over without loosing control of the vehicle. During this time, the entire car was filled with the smoke and chemicals from the airbags, and I was able to roll down the windows to let the fumes and smoke out. Upon stopping the vehicle on the side of the freeway, I then cut the still burning airbag away from the steering wheel with a pocket knife to avoid getting burned. The fact that I did not loose control of the vehicle and crash still amazes me. If my hands would have been oriented any other way, they both would have been knocked from the wheel and I would have lost control, causing who knows how much damage to myself and others.

I let the vehicle sit for a few minutes while I collected my composure, and after looking over the damage started the vehicle and drove 10 miles to the city of Madison. I drove to Don Miller Chrysler Jeep, inc. at 5339 Wayne Terrace, which was the nearest Jeep dealership. I explained the situation to two of the service technicians and showed them the vehicle damage, and asked how I should handle the situation. They assured me the vehicle was still safe to drive, although I had neither front airbag nor the driver's side seatbelt in working order. I was told to take the vehicle to the dealership where it was purchased from and they would handle it. This was not very comforting, considering that I still had to drive from Madison to Chicago, and then on to Minneapolis with a passenger and have no safety mechanisms functioning. The remainder of the weekend was spent driving in constant fear of a possible accident, as well as the worry that the vehicle would succumb to some further malfunction. Add to this the momentary panic I underwent whenever the low gas warning would sound, and I can tell you it was not an easy trip.

The vehicle was taken to Dave Marston Motors on Monday, July 1st and the problem was explained to the service manager. I was informed that a special response team would be sent directly from Chrysler to inspect the vehicle and do testing to discover what had caused the problem. On July 3rd I was interviewed by Calvin H. Compe, I.C., from E. A. Associates and gave my statement. I was told that Chrysler was taking this incident very seriously, and would be kept abreast of the investigation. I requested that I receive a copy of the report for my records, but was never given one.

I asked for, and was given a loaner vehicle by Marston Motors to use during the repair of the jeep. The vehicle loaned to me was a passenger car, not a trailer-ready SUV, and this created a problem because I had planned two camping vacations with my foreign visitor and others. In order to carry out my camping plans, I was forced to borrow a truck for the day, tow my camper trailer to the camp ground where I would be staying over the July 4th holiday, set up my

camper, return the truck, drive back to the campground with the loaner car for the week, borrow the truck to tow the camper home, go back to the campground to get the car and then drive my guest home. I was also forced to purchase a second Wisconsin State Parks sticker at a cost of \$20.00 to display in the window of the loaner vehicle in order to be allowed in the State campground, since the sticker I had previously purchased was in the window of the Jeep being repaired. All of this resulted in an extreme inconvenience to me, and my guest, and forced me to cancel the remaining camping trip which I had planned for the next weekend.

The jeep's repairs were finally completed on July 24th, after a total of 23 days at the dealership, and not once during that time was I contacted by anyone at Chrysler Corporation with any form of apology or interest in my personal welfare or inconveniences. I told the service manager at Marston Motors on three separate occasions that I wanted to have someone from Chrysler contact me and explain to me what would be done to assure me that the vehicle would be fixed and would be safe for me to drive without further incidence. The jeep was returned to me with only the explanation that the airbag module was defective. I am not convinced that this will not happen again, and adds to my displeasure with your company and the vehicle I am now forced to drive without any assurances to my safety. I currently drive this vehicle on a daily basis, which includes a 60 mile round trip commute to work and any other business and personal mileage that is required. Our company specifically purchased this Jeep Liberty after researching which brand of vehicle would best fill my needs for work and home use. I must say that we are not happy with the current situation and are considering selling the vehicle. Through my research on the websites for Consumer Reports, The Auto Safety Hotline and The Airbag Institute, it has come to my attention that I am indeed very lucky that I survived the airbags having been deployed. We are also aware that the resale value of the vehicle has now dropped several thousand dollars below what it should be worth. After spending over \$24,000 on this new vehicle, we are understandably upset.

I would also like to point out that I have been in to see my personal Physician about the increasing irritation in my neck which I received from being startled by the airbags deployment. I am luckily not showing any signs of hearing loss which is commonly associated with being exposed to airbag deployment. I underwent x-rays and an MRI to see if there were any physical injuries to my neck, and given prescription medication to reduce the inflammation. Test results showed no fractures or abnormalities, although there is a mild bulging of the disc between my C5 and C6 vertebrae. I have been told this will eventually dissipate. I am finding some relief with the prescription medication, and continue to take it daily. The costs incurred from my doctor's visits and prescriptions totals \$2,053.50 at this time, of which \$620.21 is not being covered by my health insurance, and for which I am being held responsible for payment.

I would like to have the issues that I have discussed herein addressed, and I demand satisfaction for my company's and my own inconveniences, monetary expenditures, physical injuries and mental distress. I would like to have someone from your company contact me within the next three weeks to discuss this issue. If I

do not receive any response from you within the next three weeks, you will be hearing from my retained attorney.

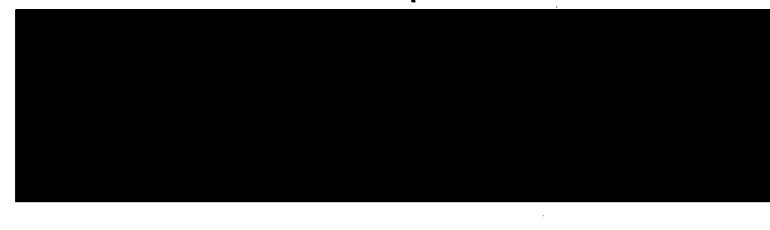

Before the "incident", we had taken our Dodge in to get it checked, they couldn't figure out what was wrong and told us they would have to contact Chrysler Corp. to find out what to do next and they would call us. After checking back with Valley Auto twice we called the manager and he in turned contacted Chrysler that day and got the OK to fix the brakes.

As the work order from Valley Auto Company, Inc. states, "customer states the rear brakes lock-up during light braking". Valley Auto was advised by Chrysler to perform testing and call them to review the test results. They did this and were then advised to replace the combination valve. This was done and the rear brakes did not lock up anymore and ABS Lamp was off.

In our denial letter it states that a <u>thorough</u> examination was done on our vehicle and photographs were taken of all the critical areas.
