I believe that I know most everyone in here,

For those of you who do not know me, I am [REDACTED] friend [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. When [REDACTED] asked me to speak on her son's behalf, I wrote something pretty short and sweet, basically describing [REDACTED] as we all know him. Then I read the paper Tuesday and realized. . . I had written an obituary... today I do not want to speak of our friend as he appears in a coffin. I remember him asking me something along the lines of how ██████████ makes his wine, and I was giving him a hard time because he couldn't properly pronounce the words ferment or fermentation. We had a good laugh, and I remember the last thing we talked about was getting together to hang out the next evening.

I was looking forward to this more than ever because my wife ██████████ and I had some news for ██████████. We were going to let him in on a secret that not many others knew about. After he passed the next morning, I was particularly upset about not being able to speak to him about this. ██████████ made me feel much better by saying, "It's okay, he knows now," but I still needed that closure.

Now this is the part of the story that I want y'all to remember is true. Seriously, would I lie to y'all? I am not saying that I can do this again or that I have some special ability, but I had a conversation with ██████████ that following night.

I was coming back from the amazing show that the ██████████ put on for Roj, and I had just dropped off ██████████ at his house. I found myself particularly upset on the short drive to Kosciusko. Suddenly, I felt him there next to me, speaking to me.

Now, it wasn't that I could actually hear his words, I mean *I* was talking back to him out loud, like a crazy person, but it was more like I could *feel* what he was

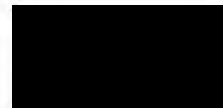


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Section I INTRODUCTION

On Saturday December 18, 2010 at approximately 5:04 AM, the Wilson County Sheriffs Department received a call for a report of a vehicle fire with a possible person inside the burning vehicle located at 243 FM 541 E in Poth, Texas. The Poth Fire Department was dispatched at 5:07 AM and they arrived at 5:25 AM. After the fire was extinguished, the Sheriffs Deputies confirmed that a body was found inside the vehicle.

Rimkus Consulting Group, Inc. was retained to conduct a fire origin and cause investigation.

This report was prepared for the exclusive use of Texas Farm Bureau Insurance Company, and was not intended for any other purpose. Our report was based on the information available to us at this time, as described in **Basis of Report**. Should additional information become available, we reserve the right to determine the impact, if any, the new information may have on our opinions and conclusions, and to revise our opinions and conclusions if necessary and warranted.

Section II
CONCLUSIONS

1. The fire originated inside the engine compartment of the vehicle.
2. The cause of the fire is classified as undetermined.

Section III DISCUSSION

While performing our investigation, we utilized the basic methodology of fire investigation and relied on the use of a systematic approach. This approach is that of a scientific method, which is recommended by the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA). This recommendation is documented in the NFPA-921, Guide for Fire and Explosion Investigations, 2008 edition. The purpose of NFPA-921 is to assist investigators who are charged with the responsibility of investigating and analyzing fire and explosion incidents to render opinions as to the origin, cause responsibility, or prevention of such incidents.

On Tuesday December 21, 2010 we conducted an inspection of the 2008 Dodge Ram pickup truck that was stored at Rick's Towing yard located at 1115 Railroad Street in Poth, Texas. During the inspection, I was accompanied by Wilson County Sheriffs Investigator Richard Nichols. At the time of our inspection, the Sheriffs Department still had a police hold on the vehicle, so therefore, we did not move or alter the vehicle or its components in any way. We photographed the vehicle as it was found on the day of our inspection and we noted the fire patterns on the exterior and interior areas of the vehicle

The vehicle was identified as a 2008 Dodge Ram pickup truck. The Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) was provided through the Sheriffs Department Report due to the fact that the VIN plate on the dash was consumed in the fire. The VIN was noted as 1D7HU18298S [REDACTED]. The license plate on the rear bumper of the vehicle was noted as Texas 65J JV9. According to the Sheriffs Department report, this vehicle was registered to Mr. [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] in Poth, Texas. Exterior views of the vehicle can be seen in **Photographs 1 through 4**.

The exterior inspection revealed that the most severe fire damage was located on the front of the vehicle. The headlamps, side markers and the front grill were completely consumed by the fire. The front left (driver's) side wheel and tire were mostly

consumed by the fire as well. The front right (passenger) side wheel and tire survived the fire to a greater degree compared to the left front side wheel and tire. The fire patterns on the right side of the vehicle indicate that the fire traveled from the front (engine compartment) to the passenger compartment of the vehicle. The right rear side of the passenger door and the truck bed were found with undamaged paint. The right rear wheel and tire were undamaged. Views of the right side of the vehicle can be seen in **Photographs 5 through 7**.

Our inspection continued to the left side of the vehicle. The left side of the vehicle sustained the most severe fire damage. We found that the paint on the left side of the vehicle was almost completely burned off. The fire patterns also indicate that the fire originated at the front (engine compartment) and traveled to the passenger compartment and finally to the truck bed compartment. We did note that the metal for the front left side fender was warped. According to Investigator Nichols, the warping of the metal occurred when the front left side door was forced open to allow for the removal of the victim's body. Views of the left side of the vehicle can be seen in **Photographs 8 through 12**.

We continued with our visual inspection of the interior areas of the passenger compartment. We found that most of the contents within the passenger compartment were consumed by the fire. The most severe fire damage was found on the contents that were on the upper area of the passenger compartment. A close inspection of the driver's side floor area revealed the presence of what appeared to be the bottom of a shoe. A view of this shoe remains can be seen in **Photograph 13**. We also noted that there were beer cans in a small cooler on the floor directly behind the front passenger seat. A view of the beer cans and cooler can be seen in **Photograph 14**. We also noted the remains of a rifle on the rear seat directly behind the driver's seat. A view of the rifle remains can be seen in **Photograph 15**.

We then inspected the engine compartment. For documenting purposes, we did raise the hood so that we could get a better view of the damages inside the engine compartment. A complete view of the engine compartment can be seen in **Photograph 16**. We found that most of the engine components had sustained severe fire damage.

We noted that the copper wire conductors within the engine compartment were severed and without being able to trace them back to their respective connections, we were unable to identify the circuit that they served. Views of the damaged wire conductors found within the engine compartment can be seen in **Photographs 17 through 20**.

During our inspection of the vehicle, we were able to obtain a copy of the Sheriffs Department Incident Report. A copy of the Sheriffs Department Report is attached to this report as **Attachment B**. The Wilson County Incident Report was prepared by Deputy Travis Beck. In the report, Deputy Beck indicates that he was dispatched to a vehicle fire with a subject possible still inside. The reporting party was identified as Mr. Dustin Winkler, brother of the deceased. Mr. [REDACTED] told Deputy Beck that his brother was not inside (the house). Deputy Beck also wrote in his report that *"It appeared as if [REDACTED] had fallen asleep in the vehicle and that the vehicle had somehow caught fire while running. The temperature outside was near freezing and appeared that the vehicle had been running with the heater on"*. At the time of our inspection, Investigator Nichols was still waiting on the results of the autopsy. Although Mr. [REDACTED] had not been positively identified, it was believed that it was his body that was removed from the vehicle on the day of the fire. Inv. Nichols stated to us that the vehicle was parked facing north and that the winds on the day of the fire were in fact out of the north. Inv. Nichols also commented to us that the vehicle was equipped with aftermarket radio components including the radio and an amplifier. These items were still in the vehicle, but had sustained severe fire damage because of the fire. Investigator Nichols also advised us that he was told by family members that the truck was equipped with an aftermarket computer chip to improve horsepower and performance. We did not confirm this with family members because they were in the process of making funeral arrangements for Mr. [REDACTED]

Based on the information contained herein, it is our opinion that this fire originated inside the engine compartment of the 2008 Dodge Ram pick up truck. The cause of the fire is classified as undetermined. It should be noted that the engine compartment sustained severe fire damage that made it difficult to locate an exact area of origin. The

wind conditions also contributed to the rapid spread of the fire from the engine compartment into the passenger compartment.
