Re: Response to Clause 11 of Remedy Agreement between BMW and NHTSA

Dear Mr. Borris:

BMW of North America, LLC, on behalf of BMW AG, Munich, Germany (BMW), is submitting the enclosed information to NHTSA at the agency's request in compliance with Clause 11 of the subject agreement.

BMW expects to have an adequate supply of alternative PSDI-4 inflators installed in driver-side front air bag modules assembled by Takata to meet consumer response to Recall No. 15V-318 by end 1Q2016. This remedy will incorporate a TRW inflator with guanidine nitrate based propellant.

The first parts from TRW for BMW testing and validation of the 15V-318 permanent remedy will be available in August 2015. Testing will be finalized by the end of November 2015. At that time production will commence, with ramp-up until February 2016.

When an adequate inventory of parts is available, the PSDI-4 like for like interim remedy campaign will be terminated. A new Service Information Bulletin for the final remedy will be released. Final owner notification letters will initially be mailed to owners of the highest risk vehicles, i.e., oldest models in highest absolute humidity states that have not received the interim remedy. As parts supply increases, all owners of affected vehicles will be notified, including those owners who have received the interim remedy.
