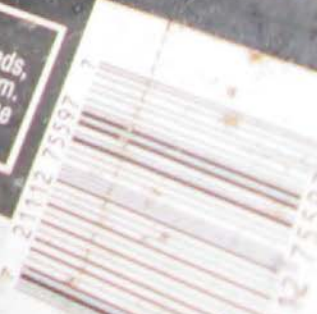

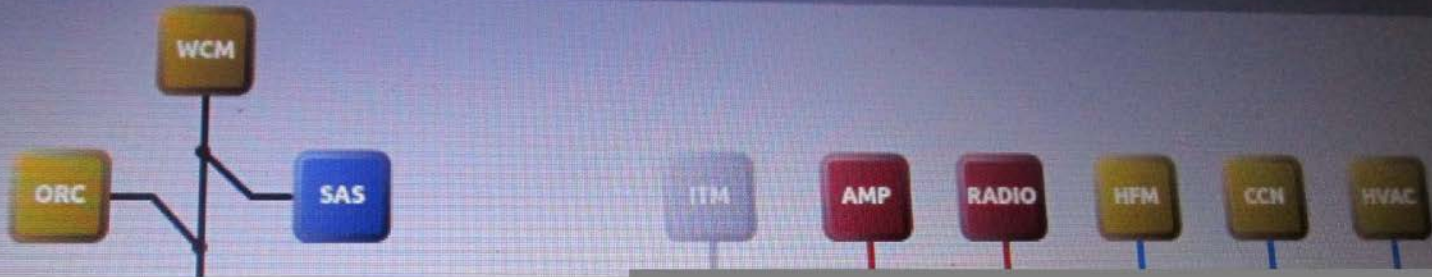

This will acknowledge your concern about the accident that occurred involving your 2012 Jeep Wrangler Unlimited.

Naturally, we were sorry to learn of this incident and the costly damage that occurred to your vehicle. We appreciate the opportunity to look into this matter.

Chrysler Group LLC provided for an independent inspector to examine your vehicle. We feel that the expense of this inspection is in the best interest of you, our customer, and the corporation, in our efforts to properly evaluate serious concerns such as yours.

The inspection involved a thorough examination of your vehicle and the photographing of all critical areas. A diagnostic scan tool was linked to the air bag computer module in order to determine whether or not any fault codes were present, which would have indicated a condition that would have prevented the air bag from deploying. As you may know, any fault with the air bag system prior to the accident would have caused the air bag light to come on and stay on beyond its normal 7 to 9 second self-check following start-up.

Deployment of the air bag depends upon the angle and severity of an impact. Deployment is not based upon vehicle speed; rather, deployment is based upon the rate of deceleration as measured by the forces of gravity (G force) upon the acceleration-type front impact sensors, or by the side impact sensors. When an impact is severe enough, the microcontroller within the ORC signals the inflator of the appropriate airbag units to deploy their airbag cushions.

The conclusion of our investigation is that the primary impact was not sufficient to merit frontal air bag deployment in this incident. Seat airbag deployment parameters were met, and proper seat airbag deployment occurred. Your Wrangler is not equipped with a rollover capable airbag system. Complete information regarding the air bag and air bag system may be found in your owner's manual.
