Re: Request to Delete/Return Privileged Documents Relating to General Motors LLC's December 20, 2018 Responses to NHTSA's November 13, 2018 Information Request in Recall Query No. 18-002

Dear Greg:

On February 26, 2019, GM discovered that it inadvertently produced three documents that are protected as attorney-work product and/or attorney-client privileged communications (the "Privileged Documents") on one of the production disks included in GM's December 20, 2018 Responses to NHTSA's November 13, 2018 Information Request in Recall Query No. 18-002.

The Privileged Documents were located on the nonconfidential (ATT_1_GM) production disk in the Q_3 folder. The file names of the Privileged Documents are: (i) [REDACTED]; (ii) [REDACTED] and (iii) PRIVILEGED PTR - TRIPPIEDI [REDACTED]_v1.

As we discussed, GM requests that NHTSA destroy all paper and electronic copies of the Privileged Documents, and either destroy or return (in the enclosed return envelope) the nonconfidential December 20, 2018 production disk labeled ATT_1_GM. I have enclosed a replacement nonconfidential production disk that does not contain the Privileged Documents. The disk is titled ATT_1_GM, Reply Date: December 20, 2018, Amended Date: February 28, 2018. I will by separate cover send a replacement nonconfidential production disk to Otto Matheke in the Office of Chief Counsel.
