## **ACTION / SUMMARY INFORMATION**

**Action:** This Preliminary Evaluation (PE) is opened.

#### **Summary:**

The Office of Defects Investigation (ODI) is opening a Preliminary Evaluation on 2012-2016 Model Year (MY) Isuzu NPR trucks for unintended acceleration.

NHTSA has received 7 consumer complaints alleging the vehicle surged forward while attempting to come to a stop. One of the allegations describes an event where the driver was applying the brakes to stop the vehicle and it lurched forward striking a building. Additionally, consumers complain of the vehicles lunging forward while at stop/traffic lights, overpowering the brakes. ODI is also aware of manufacturer field reports alleging that subject vehicles accelerate while attempting to stop.

A Preliminary Evaluation has been opened to understand the conditions that might cause the subject vehicles to surge or lunge forward.
