E23 was called back to the scene of a previous electric car fire, apparently a rekindle of the same car which crew had just pul out about 30 minutes prior. On arrival the same vehicle was once again smoldering. Crew began fire attack with all resources including water, foam, and dry chem extinguishers. Although a lot of headway was made attacking the smoldering batteries, the battery compartment which was hard to get to was still smoldering after 4 hours of different fire attack tactics. As per battalion 9, E23 crew felt the scene and had E14 continue fire attack to further smolder the batteries.
