

Here is the list of differences between the handle assemblies. See drawing part number 29412-XX.

- 29411-01 – Similar to many versions of the 29412 assemblies but does not have a deadbolt. Closes to 29412-08 or 29412-13.
- 29412-01 – Similar to 29412-13 but has long load pins (See attached drawing)
- 29412-03 – Similar to 29412-08 but has different keying
- 29412-04 – Similar to 29412-08 but has different keying and has long load pins.
- 29412-05 – Similar to 29412-08 but has different keying
- 29412-07 – Similar to 29412-08 but is supplied with mounting fasteners.
- 29412-08 – Similar to 29412-13 but allows for power locking to the deadbolt. (See attached drawing)
- 29412-09 – Similar to 29412-08 but has different keying.
- 29412-10 – Similar to 29412-08 but has different keying.
- 29412-11 – Similar to 29412-08 but has different keying and is supplied with mounting fasteners.
- 29412-12 – Similar to 29412-08 but has different keying and is supplied with mounting fasteners.
- 29412-13 – Similar to 29412-01 but has short load pins. (See attached drawing)
- 29412-14 – Similar to 29412-13 but has different keying.
- 29812-01 – This is a full-door system kit. 29411-01 is in the kit.
- 31386-01 – Same as 29812-01 (Appears to be a duplicate of the 29812-01 Kit)
- 37559-01 – Same as 29411-01. It was set up for S&R as a steel plunger version when the 29411-01 used a zinc plunger.
- 37560-07 – Same as 29412-07. It was set up for S&R as a steel plunger version when the 29412-07 used a zinc plunger.
- 37560-11 – Same as 29412-11. It was set up for S&R as a steel plunger version when the 29412-11 used a zinc plunger.
- 37560-13 – Same as 29412-13. It was set up for S&R as a steel plunger version when the 29412-13 used a zinc plunger.
