As we are closing out on PE21-002 investigation, we have the following questions for Arboc SV LLC.

- What issue is Arboc's TSB, number AR875, intended to address?
- What are the possible outcomes if the TSB wasn't performed and performed accurately?
- What is the timeline of the TSBs creation?
- Has there been any final conclusion/root cause determination for the 2 LAWA fires (December 2019 and June 2020) as of March 15th 2022?

We are making this request under NHTSA's information gathering authority (49 U.S.C. 30166; 49 CFR Part 510) to assist the agency in understanding the scope and severity of the potential defect.
