
Pursuant to 49 CFR Part 512, Lippert Components, Inc. ("Lippert") hereby requests confidential treatment for certain information submitted to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) in connection with Lippert response to Information Request ID PE24023-02.
