ACTION/SUMMARY INFORMATION

Action: Open this Defect Petition (DP) to evaluate the issue and determine whether to grant or deny the petition.

Summary:

The Office of Defects Investigation (ODI) received a petition on February 20, 2024, requesting a defect investigation into an alleged defect of the "engine" on the following vehicle model stated by the petitioner: 2016 Kia Sedona vehicles equipped with the 3.3L V-Shaped GDI Lambda-II engine. The petition itself can be reviewed at NHTSA.gov under ODI number 11482166.

The petition cites allegations of a loss of motive power, often resulting in an engine seizure. The stall is preceded by a knocking sound, sudden loss of all oil, and no warning lights.

A defect petition has been opened to evaluate the issue and determine whether to grant or deny the petition.
