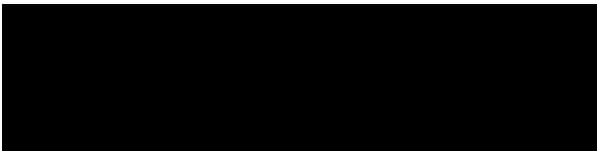
Subject: **Request for Confidential Treatment on Jaguar High Voltage Coolant Heaters**

APPENDIX 1

§512.8 (a) Describe the information

The information for which JLR is requesting confidential treatment consists of presentation materials from a meeting held 20NOV24 with members of NHTSA's ODI department discussing Jaguar High Voltage Coolant Heaters. This information includes design and testing strategy, information on product development methods, and other confidential information related to how JLR develops its products.

§512.8 (b) Confidentiality standard in accordance with §512.15

§512.15(b) Public disclosure of the information would be likely to cause substantial harm to the competitive position of the submitter.

§512.8 (c) Justification for Confidential Treatment

Documents of the type as described in §512.8 (a) are maintained under a record keeping system which is intended to control dissemination of this material within Jaguar Land Rover, and to assure that the material is not disseminated outside of Jaguar Land Rover, except as described in the attached certification, which is made pursuant to 49 CFR Part 512.4(b).

Disclosure of these documents, in JLR's opinion, could result in substantial competitive harm as it would reveal design and testing strategy, information on product development methods, and other confidential information related to how JLR develops its products.

§512.8 (d) Class Determination

The information is not subject to a class determination.

§512.8 (e) Time period during which confidential treatment is sought

The information for which confidential treatment is being sought is the kind that JLR does not anticipate ever disclosing to the public. Therefore, JLR requests the information be accorded confidential treatment indefinitely.
