Hello Tran,

The issue resulting in recall 23V-782 was contained to a seatbelt lap pre tensioner product manufactured exclusively for Honda and used in specific make and model detailed in the recall. The suspect lap pretension population may have contained products where an assembly rivet was not installed due to a manufacturing error. The missing rivet provides joint strength in the assembly to maintain occupant loading and restraint performance. No other customers (Vehicle OEMs) receive this product from Joyson Safety System.
