- h. Remedy/repair date(s) (MM/DD/YYYY) for the subject recall and/or the peer recall;
- i. Date warranty coverage commenced (MM/DD/YYYY); and
- j. The State in the United States where the vehicle was originally sold or leased, or delivered for sale or lease (postal abbreviation).

Provide the table in Microsoft Excel 2010, or a compatible format, entitled "PRODUCTION DATA." A pre-formatted data collection file, which provides further details regarding this submission, will be provided to you.

Answer

Ford records indicate that the approximate total number of subject vehicles sold in the United States (the 50 states and the District of Columbia), protectorates, and territories (American Samoa, Guam, Northern Mariana Islands, Puerto Rico, and Virgin Islands) is 51,977.

The number of subject vehicles sold in the United States by model year is shown below:

Note that the numbers above include all vehicle powertrains (1.5L Dragon I3 gasoline, 2.0L GTDI I4 gasoline, and 2.5L HEV/PHEV). Subject and peer recalls affected only 1.5L Dragon I3 gasoline powertrains.
