

FORD MOTOR COMPANY (FORD) RESPONSE TO RQ24014-1 Request 8Request 8

State, by make and model year, the terms of the new vehicle warranty coverage offered by Ford on the subject vehicles (i.e., the number of months and mileage for which coverage is provided and the vehicle systems that are covered). Describe any extended warranty coverage option(s) that Ford offered for the subject vehicles and state by option, model, and model year, the number of vehicles that are covered under each such extended warranty.

Answer

For 2021 – 2024 model year Ford Bronco Sport vehicles and 2022 – 2024 model year Ford Maverick vehicles, the New Vehicle Limited Warranty, Bumper-to-Bumper Coverage begins at the warranty start date and lasts for three years or 36,000 miles, whichever occurs first. 12 volt battery recharging or replacement is reimbursable within the Bumper-to-Bumper Warranty period. Ford does not offer any extended warranty coverage options that cover the 12 volt battery outside of the New Vehicle Limited Warranty.

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
